



Eucalyptus Tree Removal: Upper Dracena Park

The City of Piedmont will conduct emergency removal of four mature Eucalyptus trees and one Monterey Pine tree located in upper Dracena Park near the intersection of Park Way and Dracena Ave. These trees are being removed because they pose a significant fall risk and could endanger public safety.

- Scheduled Start Date: February 25, 2019
- Estimated Completion time: 2-3 weeks
- Hours of operation 8am- 4pm, Weekdays

Park Closure:

- The area of work within Dracena park , shown in **RED** on the map, will be closed 24/7 to the public for the duration of the project.
- The area shown in **GREEN** will be open as usual per Piedmont Municipal Code.
- For the duration of the project, it is important to not have pedestrians or dogs in the restricted work zone as there will be debris, equipment and the possibility of dangerous branches falling from the project trees.

Street Closure and Parking restrictions between 8am-4pm, weekdays

- Dracena Ave. between Park Way and Blair Ave.: no through traffic, staff will help residents with access during work hours.
- No Parking along the eastern side of Park Way: see posted signs for no parking zone.
