Moraga Canyon Sports Fields Project
Notice of Preparation and Public Scoping Meeting

Notice is hereby given that the City of Piedmont, as the Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), will prepare an Environmental Impact Report for the Moraga Canyon Sports Fields Project and will hold a **Public Scoping Meeting on Tuesday, December 8, 2009 at Piedmont Community Hall, 711 Highland Avenue at 7:00 p.m.**

The project calls for improvements at two sites that are located on Moraga Avenue. The scope of the work includes the installation of synthetic turf, improved drainage and field lighting at Coaches Field, which is located immediately adjacent to the City Corporation Yard at Red Rock Road, and the installation of two sports fields at Blair Park which is located northeast and across the street from Coaches Field.

The **Notice of Preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Report** can be viewed on the city website: www.ci.piedmont.ca.us. The project description, location, and potential environmental impacts are contained in the **Notice of Preparation** and in more detail in the **Initial Study**, which can also be viewed on the city web page. Both documents can also be reviewed at the Office of the City Clerk, Piedmont City Hall, 120 Vista Avenue, Piedmont during business hours Monday through Friday.

The Public Scoping Meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 8, 2009 at the Piedmont Community Hall, 711 Highland Avenue at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for the general public, public agencies, interested organizations or individuals to comment on the scope of the Environmental Impact Report pursuant to CEQA and issues to be addressed therein, including potentially significant environmental effects, project alternatives, and mitigation measures. This meeting will be videotaped and aired beginning the following day on KCOM-TV, channel 27 in Piedmont and will also be available via streaming video on the city web site.

The Public Comment Period on the Notice of Preparation and Initial Study begins on Monday, November 16 and concludes on Friday, December 18, 2009. Written comments should be provided by email to: aswift@ci.piedmont.ca.us or by mail to:
